Varying roles available for Senior Leadership Clinical Service Delivery and On-call positions

The Kilmore and District Hospital (TKDH) is located 74kms North of Melbourne in one of the fastest growing and most attractive regions in non-metropolitan Victoria. On an annual basis we treat over 2,600 in-patients and 8,000+ Urgent Care presentations, deliver 300 babies, have an operating expenditure in excess of \$18 million and operate 60 aged care beds. This is all done from one site encompassing four facilities which are made up of:

- the main hospital housing multi-day beds, a perioperative suite and the Urgent Care Centre,
- Caladenia Nursing Home,
- Dianella Village Aged Care Hostel, and an
- Outpatient Services operating out of a brand new facility.

Services are provided in home and community settings, including antenatal clinics operated onsite and from Seymour Health and Nexus Primary Care in Wallan.

On the maternity front, TKDH operates a Level 3 maternity service with modern amenities and collaborative relationships with the maternity service at Northern Health. It is a rapidly growing service, which saw approximately 300 deliveries in 2015/16.

We have new, state of the art theatre facilities providing elective day procedures and low risk overnight stay procedures in gynaecology, general surgery, urology, ENT surgery and orthopaedic surgery, as well as elective and emergency Caesarean Section. There is a mix of GP and specialist anaesthetists with 24/7 GP anaesthetic coverage.

Due to the population growth and increased service demand we are currently looking to expand our team in the following areas:

- **Senior Obstetrician and Gynaecologist**
- **Specialist Obstetrician and Gynaecologists**

All roles will have an on-call requirement which is supported by free onsite accommodation that can be utilised as required.

To be suitable for these roles you must have Fellowship or membership of The Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists as recognised by the Australian Medical Council (AMC) including maintenance of CPD and good standing as required by AHPRA for the maintenance of Specialist Registration.
