REGISTERED MIDWIFE / REGISTERED NURSE

The Kilmore and District Hospital is a level 3 rural maternity service (with a level 2 nursery) currently undergoing significant changes in order to meet the rapidly increasing demand for maternity care within our region. Our acute inpatient unit is a 30-bed ward, providing medical and surgical nursing care for both paediatric and adults clients across the health continuum; which also includes 2 TCP and 10 GEM beds providing care in conjunction with The Northern Hospital.

To help support and ensure a high level of care continues to be provided to the community, we are offering the opportunity for experienced Registered Midwives/Nurses to come and join our team.

This unique opportunity will give you the chance to gain experience and expertise in providing the full scope of midwifery care within a rural hospital setting.

To be successful in this role you will need to possess:

- Registration as a Registered Nurse AND Midwife with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) and hold a current practicing certificate.
- Demonstrated competence in the provision of nursing and midwifery care as specified in the National Board National competency standards
- Well-developed communication skills and a proven ability to work in a multidisciplinary team.
- Ability to work within a flexible roster system across all shifts with on call requirements.
- Demonstrated commitment to ongoing learning and professional development.
- Ability to provide care for general nursing and/or maternity patients
